Attractions to expect:

1. The Grand Palace & Wat Phra Kaew (The Temple of the Emerald Buddha)

Bangkok's major landmark, which was built in 1782 by King Rama I. Each building of the complex is a work of arts including the royal chapel of Temple of the Emerald Buddha - which houses Thailand's most revered Buddha Image. Only visitors in proper attire are allowed for the entry.

And the Emerald Buddha is considered the palladium of Thailand. It is the most revered Buddha image in the Kingdom.

2. Pak Khlong Talat (Flower Market)

Bangkok's biggest wholesale Flower Market. Beautiful variety of local and imported cut flowers, leaves, orchids, tropical plants are on offer from early morning till late night. **(Admission Ticket Free)**

3. Wat Pho (The Temple of the Reclining Buddha)

The most important temples of Bangkok with its very impressive huge reclining Buddha image in bronze built in Ayuthaya period (1350-1767).

4. Wat Arun (The Temple of Dawn)

The major riverside landmark of Bangkok with a magnificent pagoda that soars some 280 feet into the sky.

5. Wat Saket (The Golden Mount)

This Landmark, on the only hill in Bangkok, is of great significance for all followers of The Lord Buddha. 320 stairs take you up to the top for panoramic views of the Rattanakosin Island.
